

# What is Smart ID?

Anti-Money Laundering (AML) and Countering Financing of Terrorism (CFT) New Zealand legislative requirements demand robust verification of consumer information. Centrix Smart ID is a consumer identification service that can assist Subscribers with identity verification compliance under the AML/CFT legislation, providing a verification service of input data, including name, date of birth and address values. Smart ID can be utilised for either onboarding new customers or for on-going customer due diligence.

At the core we use our bureau database to verify name, address and date of birth data. Centrix holds trusted source data on over 3 million NZ consumers, updated monthly by banks, finance and retail energy providers. Changes to the Credit Reporting Privacy Code have enabled this data to be used for AML/CFT verification purposes.

An important aspect of the Centrix service is the focus on **trusted source** information. We consider this to be a very important aspect of our verification service and ensures that matched data is only confirmed based on the data being confirmed by a trusted source. This limits the opportunity for fraudulent applications passing the verification threshold.

Centrix recommends Subscribers should take legal advice regarding their AML/CFT identity verification compliance.

Optional inclusion of Driver Licence or Passport verification services are available within Smart ID:

- New Zealand Transport Authority (NZTA) New Zealand Driver Licence Verification is requested from the NZTA.
- Department of Internal Affairs New Zealand Passport Verification is requested from the Department of Internal Affairs. Centrix Subscribers must be pre-authorised to utilise this service for verification.

International Watchlist / Politically Exposed Person (PEP) status sourcing is also provided within the Smart ID service (Centrix Subscribers must be pre-authorised to utilise this service for verification).

#### Who can use Smart ID?

The Credit Reporting Privacy Code governs who Centrix can disclose credit information to for the purposes of undertaking identity verification in accordance with the AML/CFT legislation. Smart ID is available to credit providers and prospective insurers where the person concerned has given their consent.



### Consent of the person is required

Any subscriber wishing to use Smart ID must have the consent of the person that they wish to verify using the Smart ID product.

### **Smart ID Verification Rules**

In order to obtain a 'Smart ID Verified' 'Yes', robust Bureau matching logic is utilised and the following must occur:

• At least **two** data sources respond with a match on **first name** and **surname** 

#### And

• One data source that has a match on <u>first name</u> and <u>surname</u> must also have a match on <u>date of birth</u>.

#### And

 One data source that has a match on <u>first name</u> and <u>surname</u> must also have a match on <u>address</u>.



The above rules may differ if your organisation has requested a tailored rule set.
